When do I need to do a tax return?

## If you are self employed...

→ You'll need to submit a tax return to HMRC before 31st Jan each year (online)

## **Being Self Employed**

Do I have to register to be self employed?

Yes, and you need to do it ASAP...

- → How to register with HMRC
- → It is super-easy!

What do I need to do?

## Keep records - write these things down...

- → sales and income
- → business expenses
- → records about your personal income

What do I need to do?

## Only if you are super advanced ...

- → VAT records (only if you're registered for VAT £85,000+)
- → PAYE records (only if you employ people via PAYE)

What do I need to do?

## Keep proof - save these things...

- → receipts (for goods, stock & business expenses)
- → invoices (the ones you send people)
- → bank statements

What do I need to do?

# There are no rules on how you must keep records...

→ They just need to be accurate, complete and readable.

Don't I need to send my records to HMRC?

## No - HMRC only want to see totals...

- → Unless you get audited
- → But, you need to keep your records for 5 years

(after the 31 January submission deadline of the relevant tax year)

- → On-going training & development


