How do I chase an invoice?

If you haven't been paid in 30 days...

- → Set yourself a reminder to check payments
- → Email to chase your invoice
- → If no reply, phone to identify problems & agree a solution

Getting paid

How do I chase an invoice?

If you haven't been paid in 30 days...

- → If no solution, send written claim by post highlighting intention to pursue legal action
- → If still no reply after 14 days, start Money Claim Online (fees apply £25+)
